EGYPTIAN

This porcelain creation draws inspiration from the feminine iconography of Ancient Egypt and translates it into a decorative language rich in nuance and detail. The attitude, the movement of the dress, and the symbolic presence of each ornament recall the visual universe of the great Egyptian queens.

The piece stands out for the richness of its decoration and for the delicate engraved work featured in the headdress, bracelets, belt, and ornamental bands of the garment. Inspired by ancient symbols of

protection and power associated with Egyptian royalty, the headdress incorporates the sacred serpent, an emblem of authority, protection, and divine connection in Ancient Egypt.

Papyrus flowers are engraved on the belt, a plant deeply connected to Egyptian culture and a symbol of life and renewal. The decoration culminates in a central scarab-shaped brooch finished in black luster, a motif associated since ancient times with transformation and rebirth.





Its creation requires 18 molds, from which the different fragments composing the sculpture are produced. The decoration combines copper and gold lusters with eleven metallic colors, creating warm reflections across the matte, velvety finishes.

The result is a creation where history, symbolism, and contemporary craftsmanship come together in a modern interpretation of Egyptian imagery. This Limited Edition of 250 units reinforces the exclusive character of a work conceived to capture the aesthetic and symbolic strength of one of history's most fascinating civilizations.

Leo interprets the image of the lion through a sculptural approach that combines realism, tension, and formal elegance. The piece concentrates the symbolic strength of the animal into a bust with strong visual presence, where every detail of the modeling contributes to reinforcing its character.

The mane, shaped in large flowing volumes, frames the face while creating depth and rhythm throughout the composition. The intensity of the gaze and the open mouth bring tension and expressiveness, while the matte monochrome finish enhances the interplay of light and shadow across the porcelain surface.

This creation is part of *Animalia*, a collection inspired by the animal kingdom as an endless source of beauty, character, and artistic inspiration.

Like all our creations, this limited edition of 1000 units is handmade following an artisanal process that requires great technical precision and meticulous sculptural work.





In Hindu tradition, the Shiv Parivar represents a vision of unity capable of sustaining the balance of the world. The divine family of Lord Shiva embodies a way of coexistence, where differences do not divide but find their place when they come together.

At the center is Lord Shiva, serene, as if silently holding the secrets of the universe. Beside him, Goddess Parvati cares and sustains, with a presence that conveys calm and protection. Together, they form a complementary duality.

Around them, their sons bring new dimensions to this balance. Lord Ganesha, with his reflective nature, represents intelligence and the ability to open new paths. Lord Kartikeya, in contrast, embodies action, determination, and forward momentum. Together, they create an image where everything coexists: thought and action, serenity and energy, stillness and movement.

HIGH PORCELAIN

In this creation, that idea of harmony is translated into porcelain. Each character has been individually crafted, with precise attention to expression, gesture, and their relationship with one another. The composition not only reflects a recognizable iconography but also builds a cohesive scene where each presence integrates naturally within the whole.

The creative process reflects this same complexity. More than a year was required to develop the piece, from sculpting each of the deities to the technical, ornamental, and chromatic processes.

The finishes combine matte surfaces with areas of glaze, enriched with metallic effects, golden lusters, and pearlescent reflections that add visual depth. Among the most distinctive details is the metallic

element that recreates the stream of water emerging from Lord Shiva's head, bringing together different materials and techniques in a single piece.

The color palette combines oranges, turquoises, and reddish accents, creating a vibrant contrast that highlights the identity of each deity while maintaining the coherence of the whole. Luster details add nuance and depth, enriching the piece with subtle reflections. Also noteworthy are the 290 flowers that form the garland worn by Goddess Parvati.

The result is a limited edition of 299 units in High Porcelain that brings together meaning and process, tradition and contemporary technique. A scene that speaks of coexistence, balance, and connection.

ART IN FACTS

The **sleeve fringes** are crafted using the same technique employed for flowers, reinterpreted here through split petals.

Metallic color applied in a gradient effect across the dress.

Satin-finished hair and earrings decorated with **golden luster**.

Eternal Beauty portrays a stylized woman defined by flowing lines and a soft palette of powdery tones. The composition balances formal simplicity and decorative richness through meticulous porcelain work.

The long, clean silhouette of the dress features a metallic gray finish applied in a gradient from the base upward, creating a subtle transition of light across the surface. The satin finish of the hair and the gold luster earrings introduce contrast and complete the decoration of the piece.

One of the most distinctive elements is the fringe covering the shoulders. It is created using the same artisanal technique traditionally employed in Lladró's porcelain flowers, here reinterpreted through individually applied split petals. This work brings texture and movement to the composition.

Like all our creations, this limited edition of 300 units is handmade following an artisanal process that requires 21 days of porcelain work. The complexity of its creation and the handcrafted intervention involved in every stage of the process give each piece a unique character.

2027 · YEAR OF THE GOAT

Baby Goat is a porcelain creation that forms part of the Baby Animals collection, a playful and lighthearted interpretation of the 12 animals of the Chinese zodiac. This piece represents the Goat through a charming and contemporary approach, while preserving the essence of this animal as a symbol of sensitivity, creativity and calm.

Crafted in glazed white porcelain, the piece stands out for the detailed engraved work on the fur and horns. The deep black eyes add depth and reinforce its expressiveness.

People born under the sign of the Goat (1955, 1967, 1979, 1991, 2003, 2015, 2027) are often creative, kind and intuitive. Sensitive to beauty and naturally serene, they are known for their imagination and their ability to create harmony around them.

The *Baby Animals* collection invites us to discover an ancestral tradition through a contemporary perspective.

Custom color palettes developed specifically for each character, featuring warm ochre tones for the Emperor and soft mauve shades for the Empress.

The **engraved decoration** that runs through the folds of the robes is one of the most distinctive elements of these creations.

HINA DOLLS



During the Heian period, the Emperor and Empress were regarded as guardians of tradition and symbols of wisdom, courage, and harmony. Over time, their presence acquired a deep symbolic meaning. For this reason, during Hina Matsuri, celebrated each March in Japan, it is customary to gift a pair of imperial dolls to newborn girls as a wish for a prosperous and happy life.

This limited edition of 500 units, crafted in glazed porcelain, presents a new color interpretation of this centuries-old tradition. The Emperor's robe combines ochre, sand, and golden tones, while the Empress is dressed in layers of mauve, dusty pink, aqua green,

and soft terracotta accents, creating a luminous and balanced composition.

The folds of the kimonos, the richness of the layered garments, and the delicate ornamental details of the hairstyle and crowns reflect the meticulous craftsmanship behind these creations. The facial features, carefully painted by hand, contribute to the sense of serenity and refinement associated with the Japanese imperial court.

A pair of great cultural and decorative value, where tradition, craftsmanship, and beauty continue to find new forms of expression.

SAMURAI HELMET



The kabuto, the helmet worn by the samurai, went beyond its defensive function to become an expression of identity, status, and personal values. Its shapes, ornaments, and symbols helped distinguish its wearer while conveying messages related to lineage, aspirations, and a particular way of understanding the world.

This creation draws inspiration from those ceremonial helmets and pays tribute to the horse, an animal closely linked to Japanese warrior tradition. Associated with nobility, endurance, and freedom, it was for centuries an indispensable companion to warriors and a recurring presence in samurai iconography.

Crafted in glazed white porcelain, the helmet stands out for the contrast between the purity of its forms and the richness of its gold decoration. The large textured side crests frame the central emblem, where the horse is represented through a delicate decoration applied to the front element.

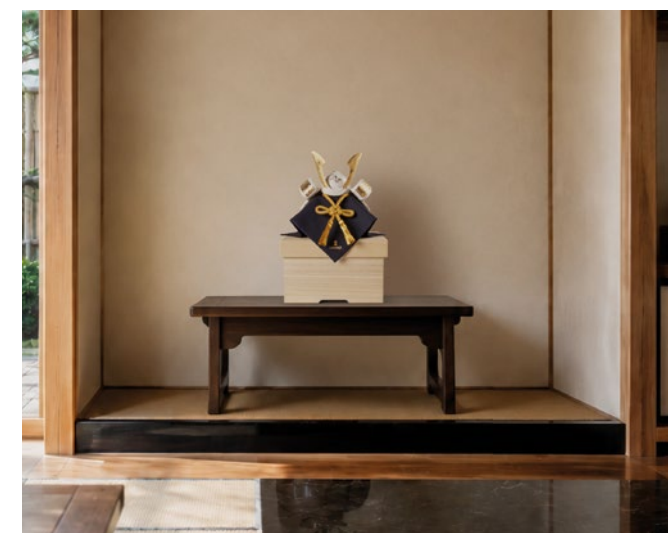
The composition is completed by an ornamental gold cord and a deep blue textile base, a color combination that reinforces the elegance and ceremonial character of the piece.

A creation that brings one of the most recognizable symbols of Japanese culture and the samurai legacy into the present day.

Also known as Balaji, Venkateswara descends in times of uncertainty to offer guidance and hope. His four arms express his divine nature and the ability to sustain mind, consciousness, intellect and ego in equilibrium. The discus symbolizes the clarity that cuts through ignorance. The conch evokes the primordial sound that accompanies and protects. This creation captures the serenity that, according to tradition, never leaves those who seek refuge.

The sacred mark on his forehead, the ritual position of his hands and his ornate adornments form a visual language deeply rooted in the devotion of Tirumala. Every detail invites a slow, thoughtful reading where tradition and a contemporary lens coexist with ease.

Spider-Man™ is one of the most recognizable superheroes in the Marvel universe. Since his first appearance in 1962, Peter Parker has become a symbol of courage, perseverance, and commitment to others.

This limited edition of 500 units captures the character in one of his most iconic poses, suspended between action and balance. The composition places Spider-Man atop a structure inspired by New York's Art Deco architecture, a tribute to the city that has accompanied the character since his origins and remains an inseparable part of his identity.

Crafted in porcelain and composed of 14 hand-assembled elements, the piece stands out for the intricate decorative work developed to recreate the distinctive web pattern that defines Spider-Man's suit. The character's signature red and blue colors are faithfully reproduced and combined with a meticulous surface treatment that brings depth and definition to every detail.

Particular attention has been paid to the anatomy and movement of the figure, conveying the agility, tension, and energy that characterize Spider-Man. The result is a creation that translates the visual power of one of contemporary culture's most admired heroes into porcelain.

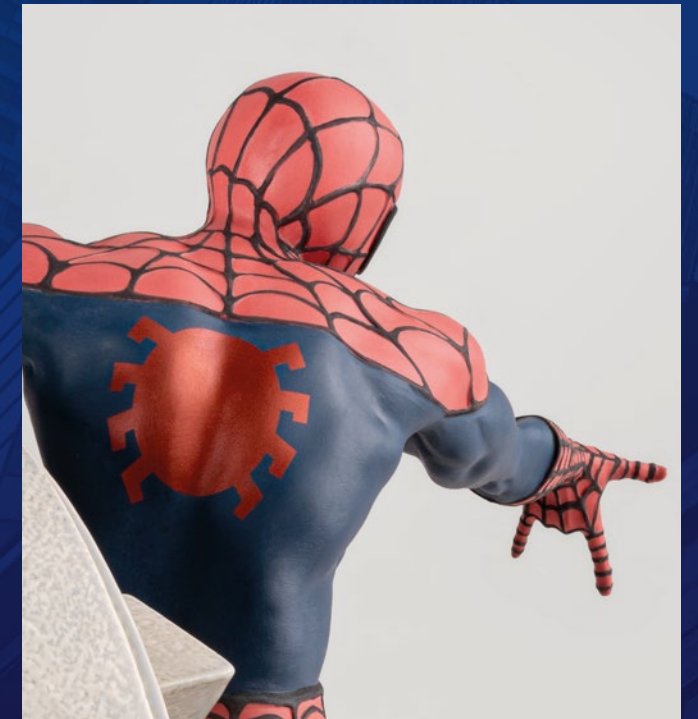

We present two creations commemorating the 250th anniversary of the United States of America.

A limited-edition sculpture of the Statue of Liberty and a commemorative ornament come together to celebrate a historic milestone and one of the world's most enduring symbols of freedom and hope.

Statue of Liberty reinterprets in satin-finished porcelain one of the world's most iconic landmarks. Our creation faithfully recreates the monument's most recognizable features, from the flowing drapery and seven-pointed crown to the tablet

bearing the inscription JULY IV MDCCLXXVI. The torch flame, highlighted in a vibrant Hermès orange hue, introduces a contemporary accent.

The commemorative ornament is a limited edition of 1,776 units, a tribute to the year in which the nation's founding document was signed. Decorated with reliefs of holly branches and two birds, symbols of hope and renewal, it features the year inscription highlighted in red. A blue satin ribbon and a commemorative gift box created especially for the occasion complete this exclusive edition.
